**Abstract:**

Patients who wear scleral lenses are at risk for various secondary complications, including infectious or noninfectious keratitis. Although infectious keratitis is relatively rare, noninfectious keratitis can become a recurring complication for at risk patients that impacts scleral lens wear. This lecture will discuss patient risk factors that predispose scleral lens patients to noninfectious keratitis, as well as diagnosing and managing this complication.
